To nominate a pharmacy to receive your electronic prescriptions, please inform the surgery dispensary or your pharmacy.

MenACWY – last academic year's (2014/15) year 13 leavers and university starters

Students - we ask that you contact the Surgery and make an appointment to have your MenACWY vaccine before returning to their studies. Patients aged 18 years of age on 31 August 2015, who have not yet taken up the offer of MenACWY vaccination, remain eligible under the MenACWY enhanced service until 31 March 2016.

Additionally, any university fresher's up to 25 years of age who have not yet received the MenACWY vaccine remain eligible under the meningococcal fresher's enhanced service.
