Test Results – From January 2018 we have widened the scope of communication with regards to giving out test results. The preferred method is for the GP to send you a SMS message or an email (please inform the Healthcare assistant when taking your blood, your contact details, you will also be given an action plan informing you the best day to contact your GP for the results) If you have not heard from the practice after five working days please contact the surgery, the receptionists will be able to inform you of your test results or ask the GP to contact you.

Flu vaccination is available every year on the NHS to help protect adults and children at risk of flu and its complications.

Flu can be unpleasant, but if you are otherwise healthy it will usually clear up on its own within a week.

However, flu can be more severe in certain people, such as:

Anyone aged 65 and over, pregnant women, children and adults with an underlying health condition (such as long-term heart or respiratory disease) children and adults with weakened immune systems.
