## <u>eConsult</u>

The surgery started using this new method of patients communicating with the GPs on  $1^{st}$  April 2019.

What is e-consult? - Online consultation and self-help advice, eConsult lets you consult with your own GP by completing a quick online form that is sent and reviewed by the practice

Where/how do I find the e-consult form? - eConsult is added to our existing practice website (banner on the home page) you can complete the form online or get self-help advice at a time that suits

How does the practice receive the forms - eConsult reports are sent securely as a short PDF directly into the clinical system, to be triaged by the staff as appropriate?

**When should I expect a response back?** - You should receive communication from the practice by the end of the next working day (however if you have a medical emergency please ring the practice or 999)

#### Hot Weather warnings - Stay hydrated

- limit the amount of caffeine you drink

- dizziness
- thirst

- headaches
- tiredness
- Store your medication below 25° or in the fridge. Check the storage instructions on the packaging.
